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NDG Purchase Orders – Cisco NetAcad™ Frequently Asked Questions

Instructors, Administrators and Purchasing Agents

Network Development Group is offering hosted Linux courses for institutions participating in the Cisco Networking Academy® program. In order for learners to access the course materials, they will need to enter a course access code. Academic institutions can purchase course access codes on behalf of learners or to resell at the academic institution's bookstore. All access codes for the NDG Hosted Linux Courses are sold by and through NDG's payment processor, FastSpring.

All orders must be submitted through the FastSpring online ordering form. Neither NDG nor FastSpring will accept email, fax, mailed, or any other documentation as acceptable methods of ordering unless prior arrangements have been made with the NDG Support team. When selecting the purchase order option as payment, the order will then be invoiced and sent via email to the address provided. A field is provided for your purchase order number for documentation purposes.

In order to submit a purchase order, the instructor for the course will first need to create the course in the Networking Academy and then share the unique purchasing URL that is generated with the purchasing agent to start the online purchase order process. The purchasing agent does not need a NetAcad account or other special access to submit orders; they only require that the purchasing URL be shared with them.

Skip to Step #3 if you are a purchasing agent and have the purchasing URL provided by the instructor of the course.

Creating the Course – Instructors

1. How do I get access to a NDG Linux course?

If your organization is participating in the Cisco Networking Academy, you can use this course for Instructor-Led Training (ILT). To create a NDG Introduction to Linux I class, complete the following steps:


- a. From the NetAcad Home page, select the Teach tab
- b. Click the **Create a Course** link
- c. Enter the course information
 - 1) Select your Academy
 - 2) Select the course you want to teach: **Partner: NDG Linux Course**
 - 3) Click **Continue**
 - 4) Choose a language and version for the course
 - 5) Enter **Course ID** and **Course Name**
 - 6) Enter a **Start** and **End Date**
 - 7) Select the instructor(s)
 - 8) Click **Continue**
- d. Verify the information is correct and click **Publish Now**
- e. Follow NetAcad procedures to enroll learners that will be allowed to purchase course access or your institution can purchase and distribute course access codes on behalf of the learner.

3. How do I submit an order?

After clicking the link provided by the instructor, a purchasing agent will follow the steps below to submit a purchase order or pay for the access codes directly.

Frequently Asked Questions

Access Codes

1. How long is the course access?

The NetAcad course start and end date is controlled by the institution. Access codes are valid for six months of access. At the end of the six months, learners will be prompted to purchase an extension to continue accessing the course. Codes expire after one year if not claimed.

2. What is the refund policy?

Refunds are available for up to two weeks after purchase for learners that have utilized less than 30% of the course content. Codes that have not been claimed may be refunded within a year of the purchase date.

3. How can I request a refund?

- a. Find the email receipt you received from fastspring.com when you purchased course access. Identify the “order number” listed on the email from fastspring.com.
- b. Email hostedsupport@netdevgroup.com with subject “Refund request”. List the order number and course access code or codes for which you are requesting a refund. **Please note: Each listed course access code will be disabled upon refund approval.** Briefly describe your reason for requesting a refund.
- c. Once approved, your refund request will be processed by fastspring.com.

4. How can I purchase access codes if I do not have the purchasing URL?

If the instructor of the course is unable to provide the purchasing URL and you are sure that your organization requires access codes for use with the Cisco Networking Academy, you may use the following URLs for purchasing access codes:

Please ensure that you are ordering the correct type of code for the course when using this method, as it bypasses the normal check (special purchasing URL) used to verify the type of course. Access codes are not transferable or useable outside of the specific course they are purchased for.

5. Are there ISBN numbers for the courses?

ISBN numbers are not necessary to order course content, but are provided for the convenience of bookstores and inventory purposes. The ISBN for access codes are as follows:
